 - 4 questions (-/+1) on 1-star topics and readings (*)
- Partial credit is available for the short-answer questions
- To receive a passing grade in this exam, you have to answer correctly to at least 17 questions
- To receive an A in this exam, you have to answer correctly to at least 27 questions
